Course outline Blended learning

Course aim

To introduce staff to a range of tools and techniques to prepare them to produce face to face and online training for their users

Objectives

At the end of the course participants will have:

- 1. Reflected on the differences between online and face to face learning
- 2. Examined different learning theories
- 3. Explored the design process and analysing requirements
- 4. Discussed and created their own learning outcomes
- 5. Considered different training methods and structuring the learning experience
- 6. Discussed how to create good elearning resources

Content

- Learning Theory
 - o Adult learning, learning styles, learning cycle
- Analysing requirements
 - o Why, who, what and how?
- Development process
- Learning outcomes
- Designing training and selecting methods that match learning outcomes

Course type

The session is a 1 day workshop developed and run by Lisa Jeskins and <u>Jade Kelsall</u>. It includes a mixture of group discussion work.
